

Dual Beverage Bubblers

Crathco Model #CS-2E/1D-16

Refill Ordering – Order from Pepsi (Case is 6/.5 Gallon Jugs)

Pure Craft Homestyle Lemonade - 8-17785-02666-7

Pure Craft Strawberry Watermelon – 8-17785-02666-4



Preparation:

1. Product is received from Pepsi shelf stable – mark with date received.
2. Use large pitcher to measure 6:1 Ratio (1 part base, 6 parts **filtered** water). Stir well with whisk and prechill before adding to bubbler.




Base	<u>Filtered</u> Water (from Pepsi fountain)	Total Yield
1 Cup (8 oz)	6 Cups (48 oz)	7 Cups (56 oz)
2 Cups (16 oz)	12 Cups (80 oz)	14 Cups (112 oz)
3 Cups (24 oz)	18 Cups (144 oz)	21 Cups (168 oz/1.3 gal)
4 Cups (32 oz)	24 Cups (192 oz)	28 Cups (224 oz/1.75 gal)
6 Cups (48 oz)	36 Cups (288 oz)	42 Cups (336 oz/2.6 gal)
8 Cups (one jug)	48 Cups (384 oz/6 jugs)	56 Cups (448 oz/3.5 gal)




3. Remove lid and add to clean 2.4 gal. dispenser bowls, refill as necessary, always keeping above the minimum fill line.
4. Store leftover mix in Cambro with lid and date for 7 days.

Cleaning:

1. Wipe down and sanitize tray and outside of dispenser each night at closing.
2. Designate one day of each week to clean bubbler (suggest Monday nights).
3. Remove all product from the dispenser and throw away.
4. Remove lid, nozzle, tray, O-rings, gaskets and dispenser bowls and take to the three compartment sink to wash, rinse, sanitize and air dry thoroughly.
5. Wipe down all insides and outsides of the dispenser with a clean towel soaked in sanitizer.

6. Move bubbler and clean surrounding countertops and cabinet fronts.
7. Reassemble and refill the next morning before opening with fresh, prechilled product.
